# CHAPTER 260

## AN ACT

1  
2 RELATING TO PROFESSIONAL AND OCCUPATIONAL LICENSES;  
3 AUTHORIZING THE CHIROPRACTIC BOARD, THE NEW MEXICO MEDICAL  
4 BOARD AND THE BOARD OF PHARMACY TO DEVELOP AND APPROVE  
5 FORMULARIES FOR A CHIROPRACTIC PHYSICIAN.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

8 Section 1. Section 61-4-9.2 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2008,  
9 Chapter 44, Section 2) is amended to read:

10 "61-4-9.2. CERTIFIED ADVANCED PRACTICE CHIROPRACTIC  
11 PHYSICIAN AUTHORITY DEFINED.--

12 A. A certified advanced practice chiropractic  
13 physician may prescribe, administer and dispense herbal  
14 medicines, homeopathic medicines, over-the-counter drugs,  
15 vitamins, minerals, enzymes, glandular products,  
16 protomorphogens, live cell products, gerovital, amino acids,  
17 dietary supplements, foods for special dietary use,  
18 bioidentical hormones, sterile water, sterile saline, sarapin  
19 or its generic, caffeine, procaine, oxygen, epinephrine and  
20 vapocoolants.


21 B. A formulary that includes all substances listed  
22 in Subsection A of this section, including compounded  
23 preparations for topical and oral administration, shall be  
24 developed and approved by the board. A formulary for  
25 injection that includes the substances in Subsection A of this

1 section that are within the scope of practice of the certified  
2 advanced practice chiropractic physician shall be developed  
3 and approved by the board. Dangerous drugs or controlled  
4 substances, drugs for administration by injection and  
5 substances not listed in Subsection A of this section shall be  
6 submitted to the board of pharmacy and the New Mexico medical  
7 board for approval."


